FRESHMEN APPLICANTS (for those who are first-time college degree candidates)

- High School transcript(s).
- SAT or ACT score(s) code numbers for Bloomfield College: SAT 2044, ACT 2540. Test scores posted on official high school transcripts are also acceptable.
- Two letters of recommendation.
- A graded essay or term paper written in the last year, or a typed, double-spaced essay on the following topic. Include your name and Social Security Number.
- Write your personal story. What makes you different from other applicants? How have your experiences shaped your life? What is your vision for your future?

TRANSFER APPLICANTS (for those who have previously attended)

• Official transcript(s) from all institutions you have attended.

Note: Transfer applicants who have completed fewer than 15 college credits must submit an official copy of your high school transcript with graduation certification and standardized test scores (SAT/ACT).
